JOB TITLE: Hydraulic Technician

GENERAL SUMMARY:

The Hydraulic Technician is primarily responsible for the assembly, service, and conversions of all products that Kraft Fluid Systems represents and sells through distribution. Additionally, you will use blueprints, schematics, testing equipment and other technologies to troubleshoot and diagnose issues.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND TASKS:

- Assemble, repair, and convert all equipment that Kraft sells according to manufacturer's specifications
- Work in partnership with internal departments to meet the customer's service and support needs
- Assist and support various warehouse and service center functions on an as needed basis
- Stay current with new product and service requirements for all products Kraft represents
- Service center maintenance (filtration and test equipment)
- Stay current on vendor service training (travel may be required) and available e-learning courses

REQUIRED SKILLS/ABILITIES

- Ability to work with minimal supervision and in a team environment

- Attention to detail, cleanliness, and quality workmanship

Must be self-starting and able to bring assigned projects to completion without constant oversight.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

A 2-year technical degree or equivalent level of experience preferred. A strong mechanical interest and high level of mechanical aptitude is a must. Preferential consideration to those who hold an International Fluid Power Society certification, but not required.

A combination of education, training, and experience may be substituted when competency in the role is demonstrated. Successful performance on pre-employment tests is required.
